The judges have made a couple of rule changes that you will be interested in knowing:

- 1) You will **not be penalized or disqualified** for going through the start/ stop line during your run.
- 2) You will be judged at the **last obstacle completed** when time is called, or your run is completed.

The **Judges Certification** will be a go. There are a good number of people interested in taking the course. The location and date will be determined once AI looks at where the participants are from and the venue that is available. Participants will be charged a \$100.00 deposit to hold their spot.

We have 10 confirmed challenges in Alberta and Saskatchewan will be adding their challenges soon. Start adding those dates to your calendars and invite a friend.

The logo was discussed, and decided that the "simpler one" found on the top of this page will be used for things like buckles and smaller items. For merchandise, we will be using the "fancier" one. I am looking into vendors and will be getting an order form on the website as soon as possible.

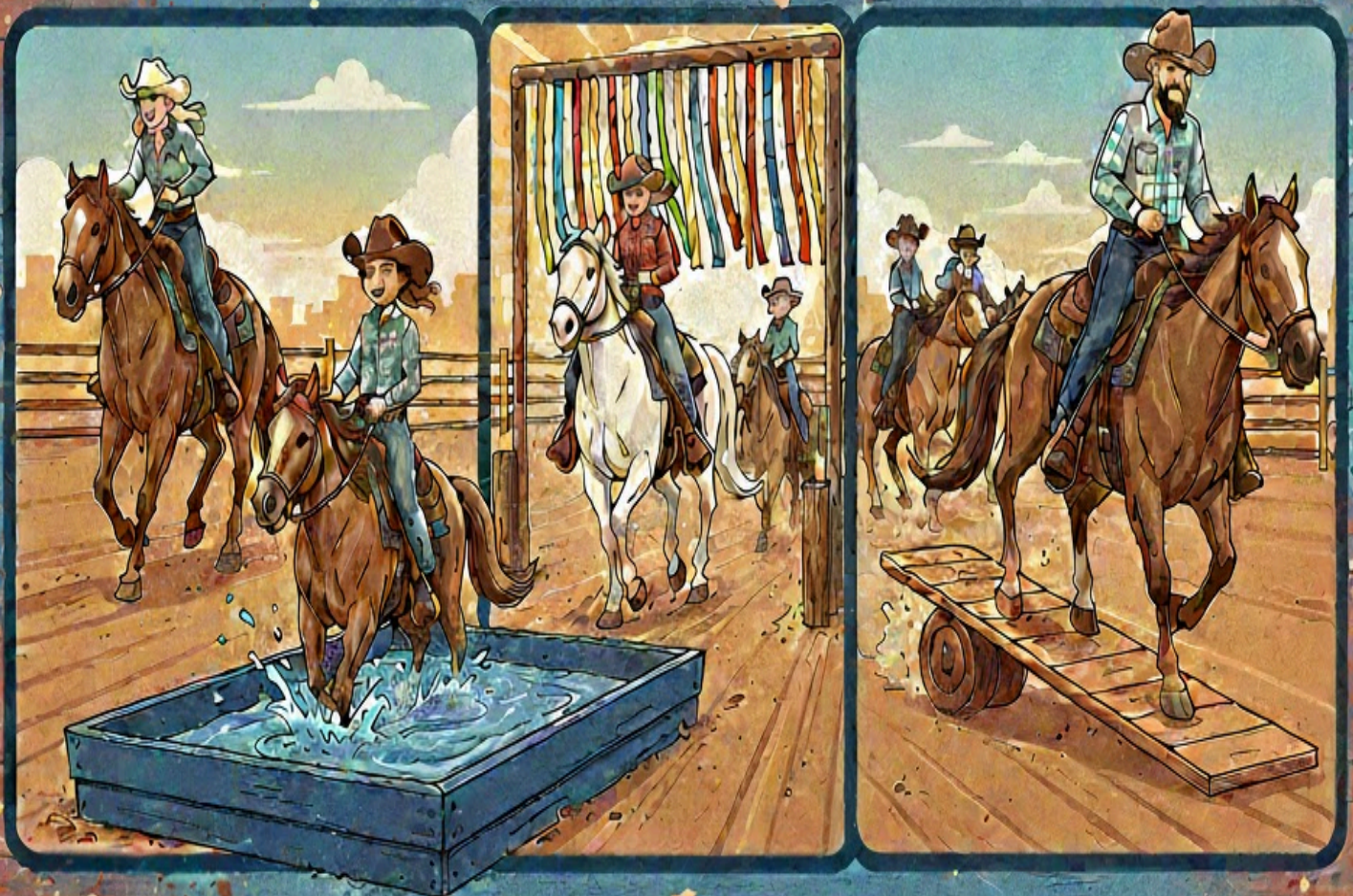
